SIG SAUER firmly stands behind the P320

The P320 pistol is one of the safest, most advanced pistols in the world. It meets and exceeds all industry safety standards. Its design has been thoroughly tested and validated by the U.S. Military and law enforcement agencies at the federal, state and local levels, along with several major global militaries. Since its development in 2014, the P320 has undergone more testing and more technical review than virtually any other pistol in history.

The US Military remains a strong supporter of SIG SAUER and the P320

The US Army, Navy and Marines have all stated publicly they are making no changes in the use of their P320 based M17 and M18 pistols. The recent tragic incident involving the death of a USAF airman remains under investigation, however the Air Force has charged an individual in the case with involuntary manslaughter and with making false statements, SIG SAUER will continue to support them in any way possible.

The FBI did not say the P320 is unsafe

A recently publicized FBI Ballistics Research Facility (BRF) Report that was done for the Michigan State Police has been wildly mischaracterized. The FBI BRF was trying to determine if something could interact with the P320 and create a situation in which it's multiple internal safety mechanisms could fail. The BRF devised several methods to render the internal safeties inoperable, including using tools inserted into the firearm through holes cut into the pistols slide to both manipulate and observe the operations. Following the delivery of the report to the Michigan State Police, SIG SAUER engineers worked with the FBI and MSP to conduct a more detailed, repeatable, and comprehensive battery of tests. The subsequent testing resulted in zero failures, and the Michigan State Police are now confidently issuing officers P320 based pistols.

(DHS ICE) are not removing the P320 from their agents

The Department of Homeland Security Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency just recently signed a 2-year contract extension with SIG SAUER and will remain P320 users.

Major Law Enforcement agencies are still using the P320

Several of the country's largest agencies have done extensive testing and evaluations of the P320 and trust the pistol for their officers. The Texas Department of Public Safety, Michigan State Police, Indiana State Police, and the Delaware State Police, among others all carry P320s today.
